- 2 MINUTES OF THE MEETING held Monday 13<sup>th</sup> July 2020 were accepted as a true record and duly signed by Cllr Colin Corbett.

#### **Decisions Notified**

**20/10/20/FUL – Drakes Farm, Musbury, EX13 8AJ** Erection of a new Slurry Store – **APPROVED WITH CONDITIONS** 

**20/1116/FUL – 10 Doatshayne Lane, Musbury, EX13 8BG** Construction of single storey rear extension; Raising of garage roof and construction of 2 no. dormer windows to front and rear to allow loft conversion; Replacement of porch to front – **APPROVED** 

## **Decisions Awaited**

**20/1047/FUL – Musbury School, Church Hill, Musbury, EX13 8BB** Construction of covered and partially sunken outdoor classroom and demolition of existing shed. Comments Submitted: **DECISION AWAITED** 

**20/1786/FUL – Sunnyside, Axminster Road, Musbury, EX13 8AZ** Construction of first floor extension with overhang to create covered walkway. Councillors agreed to support the proposal as it was within the permitted development and would keep a family in the village. Clerk to submit comments. **ACTION** 

#### 7 HIGHWAYS AND PUBLIC SPACES

- 7.1 Parish Lengthsman The Council agree to proceed with the project with Cllr Craker taking the lead. Cllr Craker to come up with annual hours / salary and approach potential candidates about the role. ACTION Clerk to advertise in the next Parish Newsletter / put posters on noticeboards if required. ACTION
- 7.2 Marlborough Road Trees these have now been cut. The Council confirmed that £500 has been earmarked for replacing the dead / diseased trees and requested that Mr Mike Lock visit Perryhale? to source appropriate specimens. Mr Rod Powell shared the village's wish to create a memorial to Jane Bishop and that one of the trees could be purchased by a local collection in her memory.
- **7.3** VAS project the Council confirmed their interest in combining with other parish/es in order to purchase a mobile VAS with the support of Cllr Hall / DCC and the clerk will continue with arrangements to install a post for the loan of Newton Poppleford's VAS. **ACTION**
- **7.4** Replacement of water tank over the winter months the Chair will investigate possible replacement options and costs. **ACTION**
- 7.5 The clerk informed the Council that the allotment tenant of Plot 27 wishes to erect a shed.
- **7.6** Allotment holders to inform the clerk if there are plots which are not being maintained properly so she can send gentle reminder letters where necessary.
- **7.7** Work has been carried out by the Cllr Corbett and Mark Perry to the bottom Allotment entrance from Marlborough Road to make it easier for vehicles and pedestrians. Cllr Corbett to send the clerk the invoice. **ACTION**

## 8 P3 FOOTPATHS

**8.1** Cllr Albano was pleased to announce that she had secured funding from Devon County Council of £1000 for the maintenance and improvement of the local footpaths. The Clerk will contact other parishes to ask about the contractors they use as Cllr Albano is having difficulty arranging work with our previous contractor. **ACTION** 

## 9 DEVON AIR AMBULANCE

**9.1** Cllr Craker informed the Council that he had now received the quote for the electrical installation costs of £6,054 plus VAT and a grant offer from DAAT (from the Libor Fund) of £3,166. There remains approximately £4,200 to raise. The Council agreed to commit to the grant and Cllr Craker / the Clerk will complete the necessary paperwork to secure the funding. **ACTION.** 

Cllr Hall stated he could support the project using the Localities Fund as this has been used to fund other DAA projects in the ward. The Clerk will also promote the project in the next Parish Newsletter. **ACTION**
